LOS ANGELES (UPI)—The recently passed women's rights bill benefits a minority of women and should be reconsidered, the national women's organization, Happiness Of Women charged.

Mrs. Jacquie Davison, a spokeswoman for HOW, said a majority of women who wanted the bill passed were trying to destroy traditional masculine-feminine distinctions.

She said more consideration should have been given to the majority of women who feel they have a "more important job to do at home."

Mrs. Davison told newsmen at the Los Angeles Hilton Hotel that men are more oppressed than women and go about their work every day without saying "I want to be free."

She called for a counter march on city hall Wednesday, the same day women's liberation advocates are planning a mass demonstration to show the country "how they really feel."
